DISTANCE: +/- 20 MILES

The trail leads to the highest point in Washington, DC.

ROUTE

1: Pierce Mill – The starting point of the trail in Rock Creek Park.

2: Rock Creek Park Nature Center – It has a planetarium.

3: Rock Creek Park Picnic Site #12, Bingham Drive NW.

4: Ross Drive Northwest – Is on a steep hill from Beach Drive.

5: Thompson's Boathouse – Can you find Mile 0 of the C&O Canal Towpath near the boathouse?

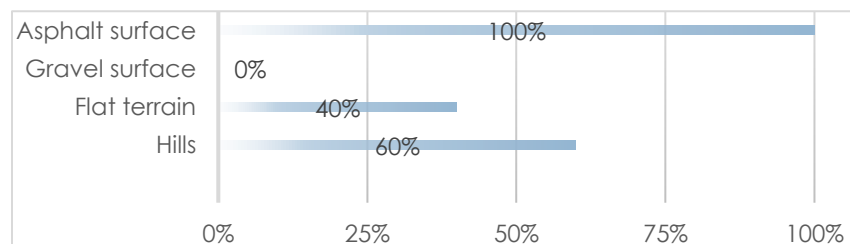
6: Fletcher's Cove Boathouse – The park is near the Potomac and has several picnic tables.

7: Kreeger Museum – Is a hidden jewel of modern art.

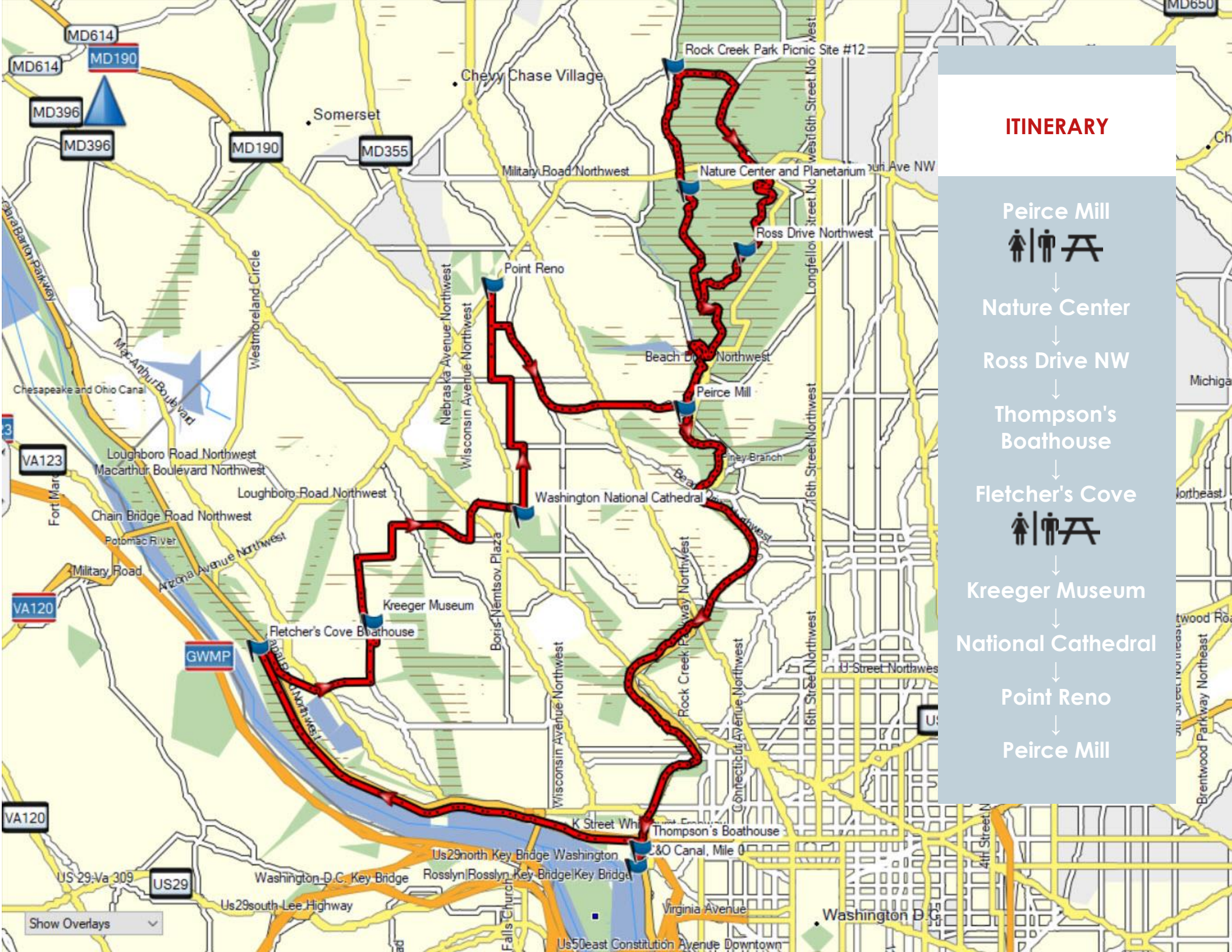
8: Washington National Cathedral – The world's 6th-largest.
