E-BIKE LOVERS TRAIL #2 MD

E-Biking from Veirs Mill to Lake Needwood Via Meadowside Nature Center

DISTANCE: +/- 17 MILES

E-bike back into history with a visit to Meadowside Nature Center and enjoy Lake Frank and Lake Needwood's views in Rock Creek Regional Park. The trail is around 17 miles and includes a half-mile excursion on foot to the Pioneer Homestead at Meadowside Nature Center.

ROUTE

Veirs Mill Local Park to Lake Frank In Google Maps, enter 15211 Avery Rd, Rockville, MD 20855 to Lake Frank. Make sure to use the biking direction setting for Google Maps or any other app.


Lake Frank - Meadowside Nature Center

From Veirs Mill Park, the trail follows Rock Creek to the Meadowside Nature Center.

Meadowside Nature Center – Lake Needwood

To avoid Muncaster Mill Road as much as possible, navigate from the nature center to Rock Creek Regional Park, 15700 Needwood Lake Cir, Derwood, MD 20855. From the lake, navigate back to Veirs Mill Local Park to complete the trail.
