ROUTE

1: Hains Point – Start at the parking lot of Hains Point in East Potomac Park.

2: Municipal Fish Market at The Wharf – The nation's oldest continuously operating open-air fish market since 1805.

3: Titanic Memorial – A statue honoring the men who gave their lives during the RMS Titanic disaster on April 15, 1912.

4: Navy Yard – The complex was built in 1799.

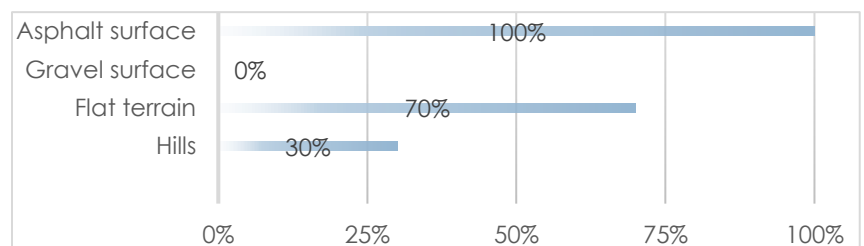
5: Anacostia Fields, 2000 Nicholson St. SE, Washington, DC 20020 – After crossing the 11th Street Bridge, follow the Anacostia River Trail to the Kenilworth Aquatic Gardens.

6: Kenilworth Park, 1500 Deane Ave NE, Washington, DC 20019

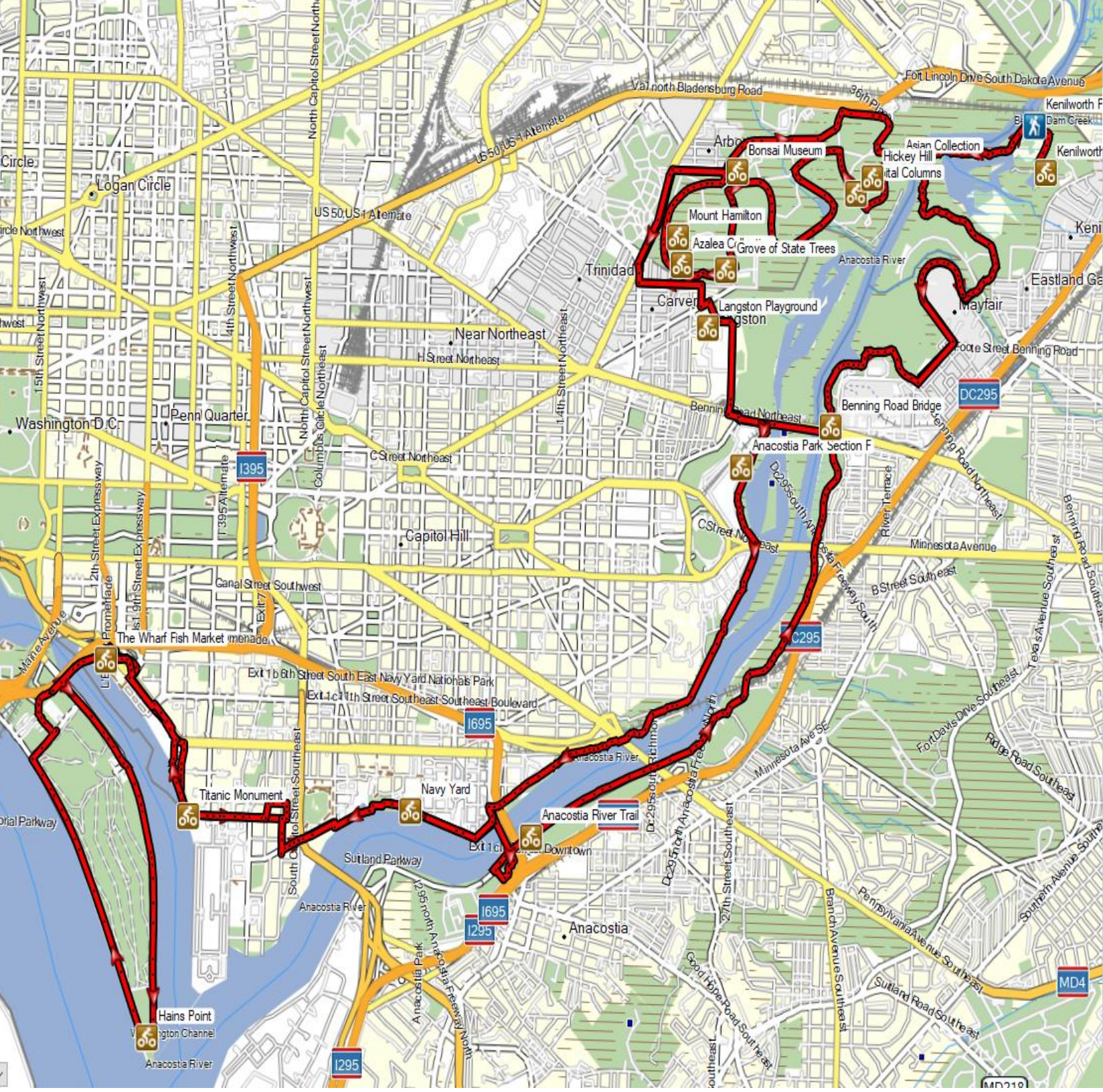
7: National Arboretum (via Langston Playground)
